SETTING THE SCENE

- The Dragons open the final week of the season by bringing a two-game winning streak into a trip to Greensburg.
- This is the Dragons' fourth game against an EIAC school this season. The Dragons are 3-0 against the league, winning against Connersville, Batesville and Rushville in November.
- The Dragons won a 60-51 game last year and have won two straight in the series. **Allie Blum** scored 12 points in that contest and was one of three double-figure scorers. The Dragons lead the all-time series 7-3.

DRAGONS NOTES

- The Dragons enter the regular season's final with back-to-back victories, their first streak since winning five straight from Nov. 22-Dec. 6.
- Senior **Isabella Gizzi** now holds all of NPHS's scoring records, as she broke the single-season record Saturday against Southport. She now has 472 points, eclipsing the 468 set by her mother, Dragons coach **Sarah (Haynes) Gizzi** in 1993-94. Isabella also holds the career (1,556) and single-game (40) scoring records.
- The Dragons had strong balance in Saturday's 58-56 victory over Southport. Gizzi scored 21 points and dished seven assists. **Allie Blum** had 14 points and six rebounds, while **Vivian Miller** added 13 points and four assists. Miller's 3-pointer in the final minute, followed by Gizzi's three free throws rallied the Dragons from a 56-52 deficit.
- Gizzi's seven assists against Southport were the most by a Dragon this season.
- Against Waldron, Gizzi scored 26 points and grabbed six boards. Freshman **Sadey Hughbanks** had nine points and seven rebounds, tying her career high in scoring and coming within one of her career high in rebounds. **Tylar Whitaker** had a career-high-tying five rebounds and four assists. Blum had 15 points and four rebounds.
- Blum has scored in double-figures three consecutive games.
- At 23.6 ppg, Gizzi leads the HHC in scoring. She is also seventh in steals (2.8). Miller is second in the league with 2.7 assists per game.

SCOUTING THE PIRATES

- Greensburg enters the final week with a winning record and is second in the EIAC. The Pirates have won three of their last four games, beating Batesville 61-22 Saturday in their most recent outing.

RECORD SETTER

Senior **Isabella Gizzi** became the Dragons' career scoring leader with a 23-point effort Tuesday, Nov. 15 at Franklin Central. Her 1,173rd point eclipsed the record set by her mother, Dragons coach **Sarah (Haynes) Gizzi** from 1990-94. Isabella is one of five players in school history to tally 1,000 career points. She scored 288 points as a freshman, 345 as a sophomore and 451 as a junior. She also broke the single-season scoring record of 468 points previously held by Coach Gizzi Jan. 21 against Southport. Isabella also holds the school single-game scoring record of 40 points, set Nov. 13, 2021 at Southport, eclipsing her mother's mark of 36 set Dec. 1, 1994 at Pendleton Heights.

Senior **Isabella Gizzi** scored 35 points in the Dec. 6 victory at Shelbyville, hitting 9-16 from the floor, 5-8 from 3-point range and 12-13 from the line. It was the second-most in her career. She has tallied 30-plus points two other times this season, scoring 34 against Roncalli on Dec. 30 on 10-23 from the floor and 11-14 from the line.

Earlier in the season, she scored 33 points in the Nov. 26 victory over Whiteland, hitting 11-19 from the field and 8-10 from the line in the 71-60 victory. Gizzi has seven career 30-point games. During the 2021-22 season, she tallied a school-record 40 Nov. 13 at Southport. She added 33 Nov. 27 at Whiteland and 31 Jan. 18 against Eastern Hancock. She also scored 31 points in the 2021 sectional against Anderson.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Junior **Allie Blum** tallied the Dragons' first double-double of the season Dec. 20 against Lawrence Central, when she scored 14 points and grabbed a career-high-tying 11 rebounds, a mark she set Nov. 23, 2021 at Rushville. It marked her first career double-double and the Dragons' first since **Isabella Gizzi** tallied 20 points and 10 rebounds Nov. 16, 2021 against Franklin Central. Gizzi has two career double-doubles, as she also had 10 points and 10 rebounds Dec. 10, 2019 against Shelbyville.

Blum also had a career-high 12 rebounds against Triton Central, scoring six points in that game.

STEAL PARTY

The Dragons had a season-high 20 steals in their 68-24 victory Nov. 29 against New Castle. **Isabella Gizzi** and **Sadey Hughbanks** tallied five each, while **Allie Blum** had four and **Vivian Miller** three to lead the Dragons.

The 24 points allowed were the fewest since allowing 24 against Southport in November 2020. They followed with 18 steals in the 75-41 victory over Delta Dec. 3. Gizzi had six and **Tylar Whitaker** four to lead the Dragons.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

In addition to **Isabella Gizzi** being the daughter of head coach **Sarah Gizzi** and the granddaughter of assistant coach **Bruce Haynes**, the Dragons have multiple ties to the boys coaching staff. Isabella's father, Mike, is the boys varsity assistant. **Tylar Whitaker** is the niece of boys varsity head coach/assistant AD **Trent Whitaker**.

HITTING FROM DEEP

The Dragons hit a season-best 11 3-pointers in the Jan. 10 56-48 loss to Triton Central. **Isabella Gizzi** was 5-for-11 from deep and **Vivian Miller** 4-for-9. **Allie Blum** and **Tylar Whitaker** also hit triples in the contest.

Coach Gizzi is in her sixth season as the Dragons' head coach. She has led the Dragons to two sectional titles - their first since 2004 - and the school's first HHC title since 1994, her senior year as a player at NPHS. In 2018-19, she also led New Palestine to a record 21 wins, including a school-record 12-game winning streak. The 2020 sectional championship victory over Anderson made her the second-winningest coach in NPHS history. As Sarah Haynes, Coach Gizzi became New Palestine's only girls basketball Indiana All-Star in 1994. She graduated as New Palestine's career scoring leader with 1,172 points. She also had 680 career rebounds. She led the Dragons to two sectional titles and three conference titles during her playing career. Gizzi played collegiately at La Salle University in Philadelphia. Gizzi was named to the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame's Silver Anniversary Team for 2019. Gizzi taught math at New Palestine Junior High and was the district Teacher of the Year in 2017. She currently works in the corporation office. Prior to becoming the varsity head coach, she was an assistant on the Dragons' staff from 2010-12 and coached the eighth grade team from 2013-17. She lives in New Palestine with her husband, Mike, who is the NPHS junior varsity boys coach, and their three children.
